MEDICARE CARD TELEPHONE CALL SCAM

Everyone who is already on Medicare will be receiving a new card in the mail. Medicare will no longer be using your social security number on your card but will be using a random number to identify you.

DO NOT give any numbers to anyone over the telephone. If someone calls you and says they are from Medicare and is sending out your new card but just needs you to confirm your social security number, DON'T DO IT! Medicare and Social Security have your information and will never call you on the telephone!

It is estimated that there are at least 8 different scams right now all doing similar motives and tactics to obtain your personal information.

Consider getting Caller ID on your telephone. When your telephone rings and it is a number you don't know, don't answer it. Chances are, they will not leave a message and it is a robo call to get you to buy something or a scam call.
