COVID-19 VIRUS PLAYING HAVOC ON OUR MEAL PROGRAM!

In this unprecedented time with COVID-19, we are doing our best to keep you fed for lunch.

Our dining room has been closed since March 18 and our curbside drive-thru pickup service has gone over very well. Keep it up until we can reopen. Call your friends and table mates and let them know if they are not aware of this service. We are doing about 55-60 per day, as of today.

Our home deliveries have remained uninterrupted during this very difficult time. **Our volunteers are AMAZING!!!!** Several have remained with us, being very careful and cautious while we are delivering over 200 meals a day. Our volunteers in the kitchen and delivering meals truly are amazing! **THANK YOU!!!**

Please be patient with us as we are having to occasionally offer a substitute as groceries are out of stock or don't come in. Sometimes the wholesaler will do a substitute if an item is out of stock, but sometimes they don't and nothing comes in its place. So, it may be necessary to offer an option that is not printed on this menu.... we just ask that you be patient. We're doing the best we can.

WHEN WILL WE REOPEN? As of the printing of this newsletter we simply do not know yet. We are in daily communication with public health officials and we receive emails from the state daily about this situation. So, when the immanent danger is over to our senior adult population, we will announce that we can safely reopen. We suspect that the word will travel quickly.

WHAT ARE WE DOING WHILE THE DINING ROOM IS CLOSED?

First and foremost... we miss you!!! We miss the hustle and bustle of the activity you all create! It is so quiet here in the building!

Currently we are two staff members short, so we are all doubling up and doing extra work. We are also doing some extra cleaning and sanitizing everything frequently to keep any threat at bay.

There is a new way we have to record all of the Curbside Pickup meals, so Karen has done a fantastic job taking that bull by the horns and getting all of that under control.

The kitchen is working to provide a constant, uninterrupted service to our clients, and they have done an extraordinary job! Not only are we offering curbside pickup, we are offering a choice. They are amazing!

CROWN HOSPICE HAS SAVED THE DAY FOR US!

Many of our volunteers are taking a break during this time, especially kitchen volunteers, which has left us shorthanded on several days.
