When you come thru the curbside pick-up, you just drop one of the red tickets into the box and it serves just like cash would. The red meal tickets are available through the drive-thru where the meals are being served.

DRIVE-BY FLU SHOT CLINIC SCHEDULED FOR THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 24

It is the beginning of FLU season, and it is NOT too early to start planning for your vaccination now. To help you, we have scheduled our annual FLU clinic for Thursday, September 24 from 10:00-12:00 noon, or until they have everyone finished. This will be a DRIVE-BY, parking lot event.

We will be handing out the simple vaccine form the week or so before to anyone who wants one. Take the form home with you and complete it and sign it, then bring it back with you on September 24, between 10:00 and 12:00. Pull into the parking lot and you will be directed to pull up and have your vaccine while in your car.

Please wear your face covering, bring your Medicare card and wear a short-sleeved shirt for convenience. There is no charge for anyone on Medicare.

Broadway Pharmacy will be conducting our clinic and they have done an excellent job for us in the past.
