MEDICARE PART D OPEN ENROLLMENT IS OCTOBER 15 - DECEMBER 7

The 2022 Medicare coverage Open Enrollment period is in the fall of 2022, from October 15 to December 7. During this annual enrollment period (AEP) you can make changes to various aspects of your coverage.

You can switch from Original Medicare to Medicare Advantage, or vice versa.

You can also switch from one Medicare Advantage plan to another plan.

You can switch from one Medicare Part D (prescription drug) plan to another.

And if you didn't enroll in a Medicare Part D plan when you were first eligible, you can do so during the general open enrollment, although a late enrollment penalty may apply.

It is important, especially if you take several medications, to have this reviewed each year.

The local APPLE Project Paperwork Service will be offering specific times at our senior center to help you review your Medicare information. This is a very important time and you should review this every year.
