MEDICARE PART D OPEN ENROLLMENT IS OCTOBER 15 - DECEMBER 7

The 2025 Medicare coverage Open Enrollment period is in the Fall of 2025, from October 15 to December 7.

During this annual enrollment period (AEP) you can make changes to various aspects of your coverage.

You can switch from Original Medicare to Medicare Advantage, or vice versa.

You can also switch from one Medicare Advantage plan to another plan.

You can switch from one Medicare Part D (prescription drug) plan to another.

And if you didn’t enroll in a Medicare Part D plan when you were first eligible, you can do so during the general open enrollment, although a late enrollment penalty may apply.

It is important, even if you only take a couple of medications, to have this reviewed each year.

SMART SENIOR SERVICES PROVIDING OPEN ENROLLMENT EVENT

The local SMART Senior Services program will be offering specific times at our senior center to help you review your Medicare information, especially your Part D Plan. This is a very important time, and you should review this every year.

SMART Senior Services will be in our building on October 16, November 6 and 20, and December 4, each from 10:30-12:00 noon, or until they are finished with everyone.

Please bring a list of the medications you take, the dosage and the frequency with you.

Don’t miss this important time set aside for you!
